St. Joseph's Physicians practice areas include:

Family Medicine: The cornerstone of our practice, SJMPC Family Physicians is comprised of nearly 70 providers dedicated to developing ongoing medical relationships with patients and playing a central role in their lifelong health and wellness.

Internal Medicine: SJP Internal Medicine group specialize in the prevention, diagnosis and treatment of disease in adults. Our internists not only provide primary care such routine physicals, but also are trained to solve diagnostic problems and manage chronic conditions.

Urgent Care: Patients do not always get sick during normal business hours. Sometimes their conditions cannot wait until morning, but they don't warrant a visit to the emergency room. That's where Urgent Care fits in. SJP Urgent Care treats routine medical conditions and is open in the evening and on weekends. What sets SJP Urgent Care apart from a typical walk-in clinic is the availability of board certified physicians, registered nurses (RN) and licensed practical nurses (LPN), along with access to on-site ancillary services such as X-ray and laboratory testing.

General Surgery: For more than 25 years, St. Joseph's Physicians surgeons have provided our patients with excellence in both inpatient and outpatient surgical procedures. Formerly known as Upstate Surgical Group, the premier general

surgery group at St. Joseph's Hospital Health Center was acquired by the hospital in September 2013. Each doctor brings an area of proficiency and unique specialties to the group. And with every surgery, we care for our patients with understanding and compassion.

Laboratory Alliance of CNY—an independent, for-profit clinical and anatomic pathology reference laboratory serving the needs of Upstate New York. Jointly owned by Crouse Hospital, St. Joseph's Hospital Health Center and Upstate University Hospital - Community Campus, with 1,300+ combined beds, Laboratory Alliance provides a wide range of high quality laboratory testing to more than 500,000 hospitalized, physician office and community-based patients per year.

Loretto—St. Joseph's partners with Loretto to sponsor the PACE program, an independent living option for nursing home eligible seniors.

Northside UP—St. Joseph's is working with CenterState CEO, Franciscan Collaborative Ministries, Catholic Charities of Onondaga County to develop an economic revitalization strategy for Syracuse's historic North side.

St. Joseph's College of Nursing and area universities—after earning an Associate degree in applied science with a major in nursing, most graduates go on to earn advanced degrees. St. Joseph's graduates are eligible for transfer to Bachelor degree nursing programs at SUNY Upstate Medical University in Syracuse, SUNY College of Technology in Utica, Nazareth College in Rochester and Le Moyne College in Syracuse.
