Supporting the community they call home is important to Vince and Marbeth Sweeney. Their involvement with nonprofits large and small has helped provide needed resources to groups and individuals whether it be through their commitment to St. Joseph's Health or the plethora of other agencies they support including MS Resources, Francis House and the St. Agatha Foundation.

She is a breast cancer survivor and her strength inspires me every day. She is heavily invested in bettering our community through her own volunteering and giving. She has phenomenal ability to be comfortable in any situation and to work a room, I admire the relationships she builds and I am grateful to journey through life with her."

Every Tuesday morning St. Joseph's Health welcomes guests to the weekly page turning, allowing for further reflection and to be witness to the masterful illustrations. St. Joseph's Health celebrated the Sesquicentennial Gala, an evening 150 years in the making, on May 31 at the Oncenter in Syracuse, New York. Nearly 1,000 guests attended the landmark celebration and were treated to the debut of a special 150th Anniversary video produced by WCNY before feasting and dancing the night away. We were honored to have Trinity Health President and Chief Executive Officer Mike Slubowski as our keynote speaker, reminding us of the tremendous value of our contributions to health care and community. The St. Joseph's Health Gala is an annual event hosted by the St. Joseph's Health Foundation and, since its inception, the event has netted nearly \$6.2 million. LEGACY OF CARING CAMPAIGN

Since commencing the 150th Anniversary Legacy of Caring Campaign official announcement in the spring of 2018, St. Joseph's Health Foundation has raised millions of dollars to support various projects throughout St. Joseph's Health system.

Some of these projects include: The opening of the A. John Merola, M.D. Cardiovascular Center; renovation to the new Breast Care & Surgery program at Northeast Medical Center in Fayetteville, NY and the Colleague Emergency Assistance Fund that supports St. Joseph's Health colleagues when they need immediate financial assistance as a result of a hardship.

St. Joseph's Health Helipad also opened in the fall of 2018; providing much needed access to our nationally recognized care "at the speed of flight." We are honored that St. Joseph's Health Hospital's cardiac care is rated as one of the top six hospitals in the nation, serving patients in cardiac distress throughout Central New York.

The Auxiliary of St. Joseph's Health Hospital dates back to the hospital's founding in 1869, making it the oldest hospital auxiliary in Syracuse. The Auxiliary's more than 30 committees and service projects aid the system, its staff, and patients in many ways. And, working in conjunction with St. Joseph's Health Foundation, the Auxiliary's fundraising efforts provide St. Joseph's Health with an annual gift, on average, of several hundred thousand dollars. The Auxiliary works closely with the hospital's Volunteer Office and many of the organization's nearly 800 members serve as hospital volunteers.

St. Joseph's Health is blessed to employ nearly 5,000 people committed to providing excellent care to our mission. The St. Joseph's Health 150th Anniversary Colleague Campaign has raised nearly \$1 million. Colleagues who support the campaign at \$500 or more are recognized on the colleague donor wall in the hallway leading to the surgical waiting area. This donor wall features historical St. Joseph's Health images that demonstrate the legacy of caring and support from within.

To date, the 150th Anniversary Legacy of Caring Campaign has reached and surpassed its \$20 million goal. This important funding will enable St. Joseph's Health to continue expanding, enhancing and modernizing facilities; to purchase and install the latest medical technology; and to continue to provide care to underserved community members as we have, for the next 150 years and beyond.





UNITY FOR OUR COMMUNITY

In celebration of this notion and reiterating this commitment, St. Joseph's Health employees demonstrated their commitment to community through the Unity for Our Community initiative. Every St. Joseph's Health unit and department were asked to consider being a part of a community service project to be completed during 2019. This project enabled us to not only highlight a plethora of need in our community, but also a means to deepen our roots as supporters of our own mission and to strengthen the bonds between co workers, friends and neighbors.

Each unit/department across the system selected a community service project that was meaningful to their group and reflected their values. Projects ranged from volunteering to freshen up the landscaping at the Rosamond Gifford Zoo to hosting diaper drives for new families in need. As each unit/department chose their path to contribute, colleagues decorated flags reflecting their service and the organizations they served, which adorned the hospital as a tangible reminder of their holistic commitment to our community.

TRANSFORMING COMMUNITY INITIATIVE SYRACUSE

TCI Syracuse was formed after Trinity Health's announcement of their multicity Transforming Communities Initiative (TCI). St. Joseph's Health convened a group of key organizations focused on providing policy, systematic, and environmental changes to promote health behaviors and tackle significant health challenges and the social influencers that cannot be addressed by healthcare providers alone.

A set of strategic partners with similar commitment expressed shared mission and vision toward the betterment of Syracuse, project partners have jointly participated on a variety of community programs, community revitalization efforts and numerous grant projects. In the paragraphs to follow, we outline some of the important work TCI Syracuse partners are doing.

T21 PASSED IN NEW YORK STATE

The legal smoking age in Onondaga County and New York State was raised from 18 to 21, thanks to the dedicated efforts of TCI Syracuse and the T21 workgroup through the Tobacco Action Coalition of Onondaga County (TACO).

The "Tobacco 21" legislation was first passed in Onondaga County in January 2018. Then, in July 2019, New York State Governor Cuomo signed the same proposal into law – which went into effect in November.

Since 2017, TCI secured multiple stories in local media to influence government officials, community leaders and policymakers to advocate for this legislation. Syracuse.com, the Daily Orange, NewsChannel 9, CNY Central and Spectrum News covered this issue. TCI also successfully advocated a favorable editorial by the Post Standard and wrote a story for Syracuse Woman Magazine.

TCI also produced a Public Service Announcement video that was distributed to local TV stations and launched a digital advertising campaign to promote the new legislation.

In addition, TCI partnered with the Lerner Center to survey all Syracuse City School District buildings, and installed Tobacco Free Zone signs in English and Spanish across city schools.

At this year's State Fair, Upstate University Hospital along with TCI and TACO, distributed 600 free nicotine replacement therapy kits. A social media and digital advertising campaign also promoted the free kits.

HEALTHY CORNER STORES

The Healthy Corner Store program, funded by the Onondaga County Health Department (OCHD) and TCI, provides easier access to healthy foods by transforming local stores and making healthier items more visible.

Nearly a dozen corner shops and small retailers in the Northside and Near Westside neighborhoods – particularly those that are within 1,000 feet of schools – received mini-grants and technical assistance to update the store.

Stores now prominently display fruits and vegetables, low fat dairy, healthy snacks, whole grain products, and bottled water. They also offer healthy pre-made sandwiches and salads, and use special tags on shelves to make these products more visible to shoppers.

BREASTFEEDING

TCI and OCHD launched a campaign in April and May (around Mother's Day) to encourage and normalize breastfeeding. The campaign included advertisements on social media, digital platforms and Centro bus stops. As a result, the campaign received coverage from local news media.

Most recently, TCI and OCHD launched a second breastfeeding campaign in August for World Breastfeeding Week and National Breastfeeding Awareness Month by gathering testimonials from local celebrities and influencers. This campaign also included digital ads and was covered by local news media.



SKIDDY PARK 10TH ANNIVERSARY MULTICULTURAL BLOCK PARTY

The Near Westside Initiative hosted its 10th annual Multicultural Block Party at Skiddy Park this summer. The goal of the free event was to spread good news about the neighborhood and allow residents to interact with service providers to which they may not normally get the chance.

Respect the Culture was the theme of this year's party. Neighborhood residents enjoyed live music, dancing, food, inflatables, face painting, a dunk tank, balloon animals, games and more.

Syracuse Mayor Ben Walsh and members of the Syracuse Police Department also participated in the festivities.

Several TCI partners also set up booths with information, healthy foods, and other samples – along with over 50 other organizations.

ST. JOSEPH'S HEALTH FOUNDATION INNOVATIVE MINI-GRANT PROGRAM

St. Joseph's Health Foundation sponsored a system-wide 2019 Innovative Mini-Grant Program and awarded over \$38,000 in funding. The Foundation allocated \$40,000 for the program. Units and departments were invited to apply for a mini-grant for up to \$5,000 for projects or items that were not included in their capital budget. 2019 themes focused on: Access to Care, ED Throughput & Efficiency, Length of Stay, Zero Harm and Care Coordination with key focus areas of Patient Experience, Quality / Readmissions & Patient Progression. The goal of the program is to encourage colleagues to think about innovative initiatives that coincide with our mission and focus areas.

The Innovative Mini-Grant selection committee is comprised of 15 system colleagues who review and rate each application. 31 applications were received with funding requests over \$83,000. 12 grants were awarded to staff across the St. Joseph's system.

INNOVATIVE MINI-GRANT PROGRAM SUPPORTS BEREAVEMENT JOURNEY



St. Joseph's Health Foundation's Innovative Mini-Grant Program has enabled units throughout the system to improve and enhance care provided to patients. Since its inception in 2005, the program has awarded over \$660,000 in funding for projects and initiatives throughout the St. Joseph's Health network. In 2019, 12 grants totaling more than \$38,000 were awarded to St. Joseph's Health colleagues.

The Spiritual Care team is a vital resource that addresses the spiritual needs of St. Joseph's patient's families who have recently lost a loved one. In support of these efforts, Eunice Champlin, a chaplain at St. Joseph's Health, along with members of her team, applied for and received funding for a Spiritual Care Family Grief Packet through the Innovative Mini-Grant Program.

"Our Help and Hope for the Grieving packet is designed to provide hope and spiritual care for family members following the loss of a loved one," said Champlin. "The packet is provided at no cost to the family and includes tools to assist family members in their grief journey. Coping with the death of a loved one does not end when a family leaves the hospital."

The Help and Hope packets include tools to aid families in dealing with loss. Informational and spiritual content may be customized through pamphlets such as *When Your Parent Dies* or *When Your Grandparent Dies*; as well as spiritual content *12 Reflections for the First 12 Weeks of Grief* and *A Healing Year: 12 Essentials for the First Months of Grief*.

"Grief is a very personal journey and there is no set timeline for healing," said Champlin. "As the Spiritual Team, we want to assist families in their unique bereavement experience through tools that let them know they are not alone on the journey, and that provide comfort and support."

In addition to the pamphlets, the packets include a brochure for bereavement services available through St. Joseph's Health Spiritual Care Office, and information on community grief support groups. The team has

also purchased small teddy bears to give out as appropriate, and each packet comes with a small wooden heart.

"We are grateful to have received one of the 2019 Mini-Grants, as it has allowed us to create this much needed resource for our families," said Champlin. "It is comforting to know that these funds are available to us and provide opportunities to expand our ministry in the community."

The objective of the Innovative Mini-Grant Program is to encourage colleagues to find innovative ways to enhance patient care that might not otherwise be included in their departmental budget. The grant selection committee is comprised of multi-disciplinary colleagues from across the system including financial services, supply chain management, Information Services, and a wide spectrum of clinical staff.

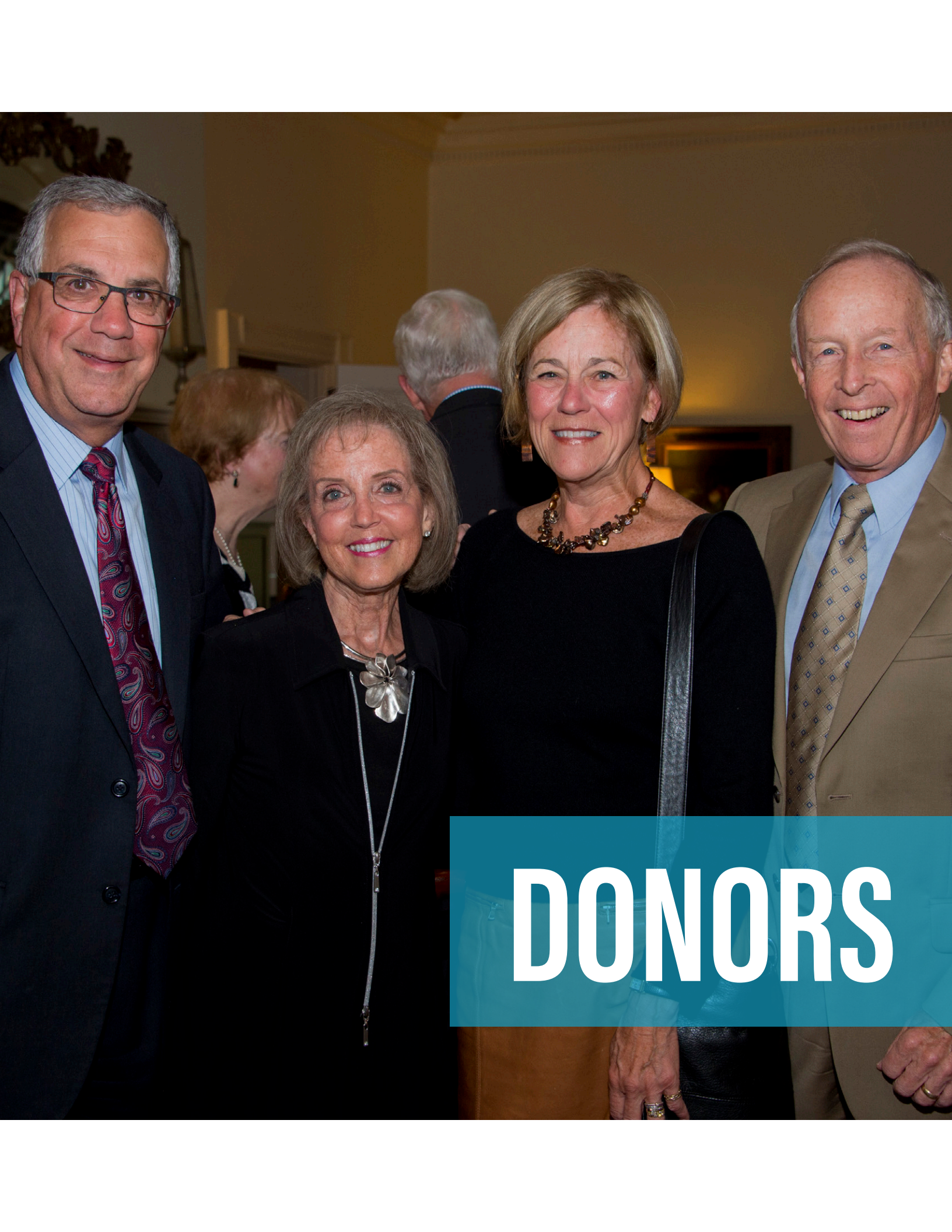

COLLEGE OF NURSING



St. Joseph's College of Nursing graduated 151 students in 2019; 76 graduates from the evening/weekend option and 75 from the weekday option. The Associate Degree in Applied Science (A.A.S.) with a major in nursing was conferred on graduates in both options. Some graduates in the Accelerated Dual Degree Partnership in Nursing (A-DDPN) option also earned a Bachelor's of Science degree from Le Moyne College. The Auxiliary of St. Joseph's Health Hospital is an exceptional group of men and women, who continually give of their time, compassion and dedication to the St. Joseph's Health system.

The Auxiliary continues to provide services to St. Joseph's, by serving the needs of the institution and assisting administration in any and every way possible. The Auxiliary Membership is made up of over 500 dedicated men and women, and dates back to the establishment of the hospital in 1869, and was begun shortly thereafter by Hannah Pease. The Auxiliary Board is made up of over 30 women who volunteer their time supporting the health center and their needs.

The Auxiliary has gone through some changes this past year, and will continue to do so as health care continues to change and grow based on the needs of our patients. As stewards of St. Joseph's, the Auxiliary supported the following services:

OPERATION BACKPACK

Operation backpack for our Kids donated more than 800 backpacks to children at their annual physicals at Primary Care Center, Family Medicine, Dental, West Pediatrics, Specialty Services, West Family Medicine, and Mental Health James Street locations. The thousands of notebooks, paper, pens, pencils, rulers, tissues, folders and crayons were donated by the caring colleagues of St. Joseph's and members of the Auxiliary. This marked the 15th year of the Auxiliary's participation in the Operation Backpack Program, with more than 10,000 backpacks having been filled since the program's inception.

THE GIFT SHOP

The gift shop, managed by Lori's Gifts and overseen by the Auxiliary, continues to serve our patients and staff. All proceeds continue to go through the Auxiliary as well and are part of the annual gift to the hospital.

SCHOLARSHIPS

The Sister Wilhelmina Scholarship and The Sister Mary Obrist Scholarship were awarded to two students attending St. Joseph's College of Nursing.

THE ELLEN NEEDHAM PEDIATRIC NEEDS FUND

The Ellen Needham Pediatric Needs Fund honors the memory of Ellen Needham, daughter of Dr. and Mrs. Dwight Needham, who passed away in 1948. Donations are received from those who wish to memorialize someone who has passed or honor someone who is living. An annual mass is also said in the chapel at the hospital.

VOLUNTEER LUNCHEON

The Auxiliary hosted the Annual Volunteer Luncheon at Justin's Grill, where over 200 volunteers were in attendance celebrating and being recognized for their tireless dedication to St. Joseph's Health.

HOLY GROUNDS

Holy Grounds Café continues to serve the patients, public and staff, and will continue to do so under new management, as St. Joseph's Hospital Health Nutritional Services has assumed the daily operations of the coffee shop. The vending machines were moved to the lobby area, as expansion and additional services will be provided by the coffee shop under the new management. The Auxiliary will continue to oversee the coffee shop, and proceeds will continue to be part of the annual gift to the hospital.

THE CARE AND SHARE CLOSET

The Care and Share closet continues to serve patients who are in need of new clothing and shoes upon their departure from the Emergency Department.



In May, the Annual Meeting and Luncheon was held at the DoubleTree Hotel in Syracuse, NY. A new slate of officers was elected. A highlight of the afternoon meeting and luncheon was the presentation of the Hannah Fuller Pease Award. This award is given to an Auxilian who exemplifies service to the organization with particular emphasis on values that Mrs. Pease championed for the hospital. This year's award was presented most deservedly to Jo Celio, who has tirelessly served the Auxiliary for over 36 years.

At the Annual Luncheon and Meeting, the Auxiliary presented to the St. Joseph's Health Foundation a gift of \$90,000. The gift was allocated to the Colleague Emergency Fund, a newly created endowment also known as the Living Mission Fund. This program was established to make funds available for regular full-time, part-time, and per diem colleagues who face a financial hardship. The funds for this gift were

generated from the services that the Auxiliary offers and manages throughout the hospital, including the coffee shop, gift shop, baby photos, and annual Wine Tasting event.

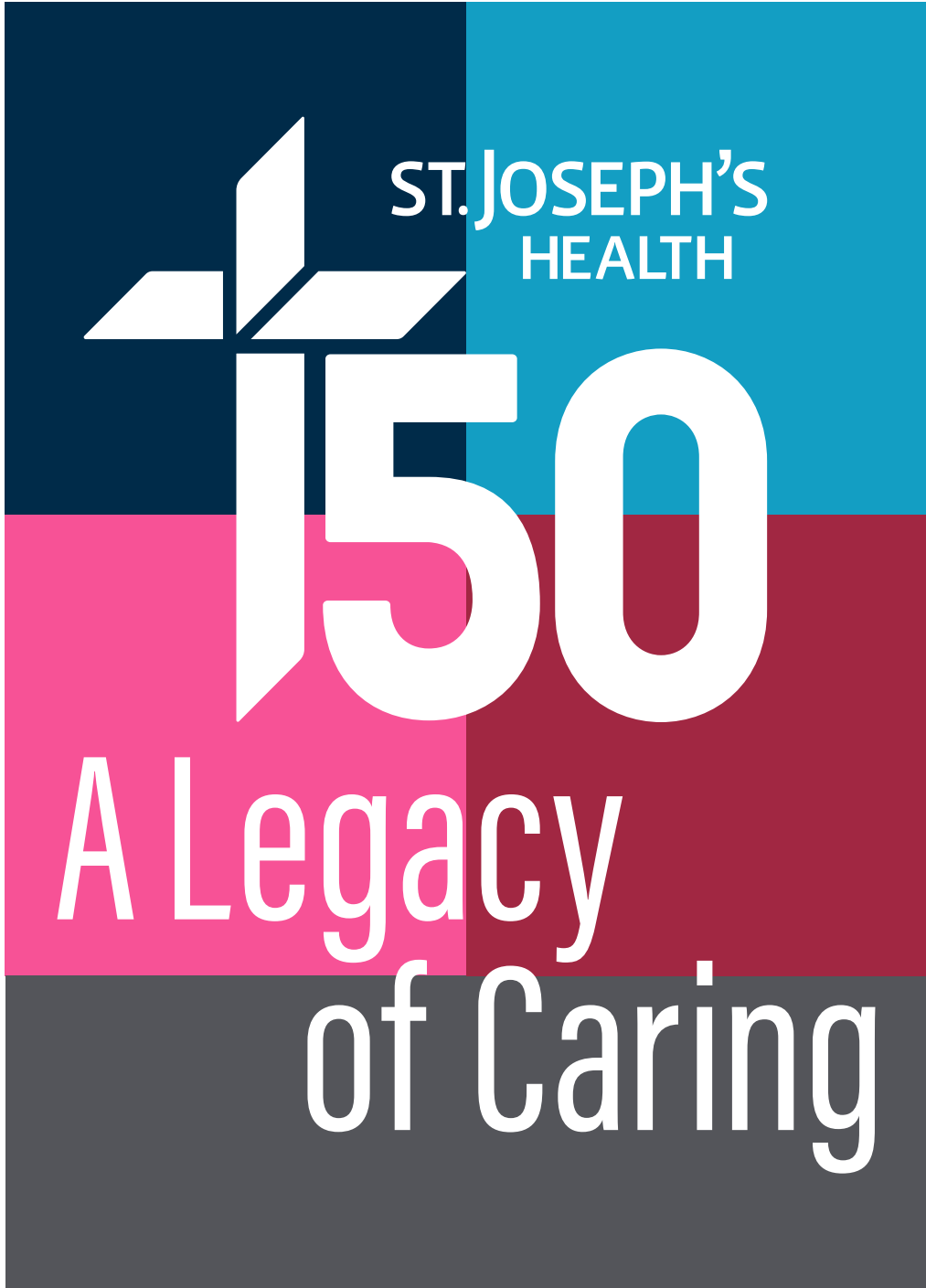
