




When I Go To the Surgery Center




I am going to North Medical Center. The doctors and nurses will help me to stay healthy. It is important to stay healthy.




When I get to North Medical Center, we will take the elevator to the 5th floor.




We will go into a dressing room where

be put on my wrist.




I will sit on a bed in a small room. The doctors and nurses will say hello. It can be fun to meet new people.



The nurse will put a blood pressure cuff on my arm. It will give my arm a hug and then loosen up. Then the nurse will take it off.




The nurse will also put a thermometer in my ear to check my temperature. I will hear 3 beeps.




The nurse will ask us questions while I sit on the bed with a blanket.




I can play quietly on the bed while I wait.




I will say goodbye to mom and dad for a little while.




The doctor will put a mask on my face that will help me fall asleep for a little while.
